

## **SEIC Members Meet With Pinal County Officials**

SaddleBrooke External Affairs and Information Commission (SEIC) traveled to Florence to hear a presentation given by county officials. Questions were submitted in advance pertaining to the concerns of SaddleBrooke residents. Ken Buchanan (Assistant County Manager for Development Services), Jerry Stabley (Planning and Development Director), and staff members from the Department of Public Works were in attendance.

A PowerPoint presentation was used to answer questions, and the County representatives provided additional and chronology information on the Eagle Crest development, commercial developments on both the north and south sides of SaddleBrooke Boulevard, traffic impact guidelines, and the paving of Park Link Drive, which is located between Highway 79 and I-10.

Discussion and questions were focused on the possibility of a school north of SaddleBrooke Boulevard, a regional hospital, State Land, residential developments to the north, status of development on the west side of Oracle Road and SaddleBrooke Boulevard, impact of Pinal County Comprehensive Plan on our area, and several other key areas of interest.

SEIC will review all the information and submit future TWO'S NEWS and *Communicator* articles regarding the above information beginning next month. A list of information materials (e.g. area maps, development plans, proposed public improvements, etc.) obtained during the meeting will be made available to SaddleBrooke homeowners.
