The Pinal County Comprehensive Plan

DIG has made a commitment to monitor government activity in Pinal County, specifically in those areas that have a potential impact on SaddleBrooke. As part of that process, we will keep you updated on the recently completed Pinal County Comprehensive Plan. This action plan addresses land use and transportation issues identified through feedback from citizens who attended county-wide workshops held throughout 2007.

The plan's goals are to:

- Create consensus on land use
- Address environmental sustainability
- Preserve open space
- Link development with transportation
- Develop employment areas
- Create population centers
- Improve quality of life

This year's continuing series of meetings will focus on alternative plans to address the important issues identified last year. One such meeting was held at the DesertView Theater on Wednesday, February 27. DIG will summarize key areas of discussion and findings from the meeting and publish them on the HOA #1 web site and in the next *Communicator*.

To further our level of understanding, DIG has invited Jerry Stabley, the Project Manager for Pinal County Planning, to brief SaddleBrooke homeowners on the plan and its progress.
